DFG & Fraunhofer: Trilateral Transfer Projects

Scientists from universities, Fraunhofer Institutes together with application partners can apply for funds for max. 3 years.

Projects must at least have <u>TLR 4</u> (Technology Readiness Level) and development during funding is expected to lead to a prototype with the intention for commercialization of results.

BIF PhD / MD Fellowships

The **Boehringer Ingelheim Fonds (BIF)** awards **PhD or MD fellowships** of 2 to 3.5 years to outstanding junior scientists worldwide who wish to pursue an ambitious PhD project in basic biomedical research in an internationally leading laboratory. There is also a **travel grant** for PhD, medical students and Postdocs
